Each year, the Columbus, Ohio-based law firm of Kegler Brown Hill + Ritter awards a Diversity Scholarship to a first-year law student, based on academic performance, personal accomplishments, community involvement, and a commitment to diversity, equity + inclusion. The Diversity Scholarship recipient will join the firm's summer associate class and receive standard summer associate compensation, as well as a \$10,000 stipend upon the successful completion of the 2025 Kegler Brown summer program.

All first-year law students who will advance the diversity, equity + inclusion mission of Kegler Brown Hill + Ritter are eligible to apply. Applicants must be enrolled and in good standing at an ABA-accredited law school with an anticipated graduation date of 2027.
